We are happy to prepare fish batter using gluten-free ingredients. However, due to space constraints we are unable to fry the food in a separate fryer. In addition, wheat flour is used extensively in our kitchen and cross contamination is likely. We do not recommend those with Celiac disease or any other serious gluten allergy eat at our pub. Sorry.

Starters & Specialties

Tea & Scones - \$7.50/\$9.00. Discover the delights of South-West England. A scrumptious scone served with real Double Devonshire cream and strawberry jam along with a mug or medium pot of tea of your choice, delicious!

Scone - \$5.00.** Served with Double Devonshire cream and jam.

Crumpets - \$4.00.** Two crumpets toasted, served with jam and butter.

Scotch Egg - \$6.25. Delicious food and popular snack in the UK. A hard-boiled egg, wrapped in seasoned sausage, rolled in breadcrumbs and fried to perfection. Served hot or cold with a side of hot mustard or Branston pickle.

Sausage Rolls (3) - \$4.00. Bite-sized portions of seasoned sausage wrapped and baked in puff pastry. Try it with hot mustard or Branston pickle.

Sausage Rolls (6) - \$7.50. Served with hot mustard and/or Branston pickle.



Haggis and Mash Sampler - \$7.00. A combination of meats made from the heart, liver and kidney of a sheep, cooked with oats and spices. Try a small portion of haggis so you can say you have tried it!

NEW: Poutine (English) - \$8.00. Our Cornish pasty filling (seasoned ground beef and pork) over fries with melted shredded cheddar and gravy. Absolutely delicious!

Breaded cheese curds or Hot Pepper Curds - \$7.25. Battered and fried curds of cheddar cheese with ranch.

Breaded mushrooms - \$6.75. Button mushrooms, battered, fried, and served with ranch dip or garlic mayo.

Chicken & Cheese with Jalapeno or Chicken Cordon Bleu Mini Bites – (\$7.50 for 6 or \$10.50 for 10).

Soup of the Day – (Cup \$4.00, Bowl \$4.50). A cup or bowl of our soup of the day.

Cheese Plate – (Regular \$13.50, Small \$9.75). A generous selection of imported cheeses served with crackers, pecans and dried apricots and chutney. Cheese selection may include: Cranberry Wensleydale, Stilton, Double Gloucester, Red Leicester, Caerphilly (Welsh), Tipperary Irish Cheddar, and Cheshire (*based on availability*).

Fish & Chips - \$12.00. Our signature dish. An Atlantic cod fillet fried in our very own home-style batter. Served with chips and one tartar sauce.

Please note, we do not use a separate fryer and cannot guarantee **zero** gluten in **any** of our food – cross contamination is likely due to the extensive use of wheat flour in our kitchen. Sorry.

Ploughman's Lunch - \$10.95. A pub classic; a simple meal consisting of cold meats, cheeses and bread - popular with farmers in rural England. Our Ploughman's comes with cold honey-roast ham, bread, English aged cheddar, a hard boiled egg, pickled onions, sliced apples, tomatoes, spring onions, cucumber and chutney.

Fish Sandwich - \$9.50. A generous portion of our fried cod served on a Kaiser bun.

Bangers & Mash - \$10.25. Marcus' famous banger recipe, made for us right here in Iowa by Mike's Meats in Carroll. Two delicious Iowa bangers (pork sausages) are served on a bed of mashed potatoes with a beef and onion gravy. The ultimate comfort food! Small portion available for \$7.50.



Haggis & Mash - \$9.95. The entrée-sized portion for those who know they like it!! A combination of meats made from the heart, liver and kidneys of a sheep, cooked with oats and spices.

Chicken Curry - \$9.75. Curry is one of the most popular foods in Britain, so much so that it has become known as our national dish! Juicy meat and potatoes with diced tomato in a rich sauce, served with Basmati rice.

Vegetarian Curry - \$9.00.** Made with zucchini, cauliflower, squash, potatoes, diced tomatoes and chickpeas. Served with Basmati rice.
